# ROSKILDE CATHEDRAL

Roskilde Cathedral has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List since 1995 – a list including the most spectacular monuments in the world, such as the Pyramids and the Wall of China. Join us to hear the history of the Cathedral, visiting the royal burial chapels and studying the gorgeous altar. Any special interests/wishes you might have will also be included.

A general conducted tour takes one hour, but it can be combined with a visit to the Cathedral Museum or special focus on the Cathedral's works by the Danish artists Peter Brandes and Bjørn Nørgaard (90 minutes).

The tour is available in English, German, French, Swedish and Danish. The price does not include entrance fee for Roskilde Cathedral.

## THE VIKING SHIP MUSEUM

Go on a voyage with the Vikings, exploring the five Skuldelev ships excavated from Roskilde Fjord in 1962. The ships relate the history of the Vikings as warriors and excellent traders, who got acquainted with new cultures, religions and traditions on their long sea voyages, thus broadening their outlook on the surrounding world. Hear where the Vikings went, what they brought home and, above all, how they built the impressive ships that would stand the hardships of the long voyages.

The tour takes one hour and is available in English, German, French, Swedish and Danish. The price does not include entrance fee for the Viking Ship Museum.

## GET THE HISTORY OF THE FORMER CAPITAL OF DENMARK – JOIN A **CITY WALK IN ROSKILDE**

In former times, Roskilde was the capital of Denmark, actually of the whole of Northern Europe. Church and Crown were concentrated here, and the traces of those days are still seen throughout Roskilde. A city walk brings you closer to history: One of the places visited is Stændertorvet, a market square that is also the site of the city's old Town Hall, and beneath the square a church ruin is still preserved. Of course, we also study both Roskilde Cathedral and Roskilde Palace from outside.

The walk takes one hour, but 90 minutes' walks are also organised, including Hotel Prindsen and the statue of Lise Nørgaard in the pedestrian street. The walks are available in English, German, French, Swedish and Danish.

For centuries, the Convent was home to unmarried noblewomen, whose families had bought a place for them at an early age. Join this exciting tour to hear the story of Blackfriars, noblewomen, convent life and, of course, the history behind today's structure. You will also visit the beautiful Banqueting Hall and the Convent's own Chapel that holds a list of very special stories.

## **WALK OF THE SPRINGS**

Roskilde used to have 24 named springs and wells, eight of them having been preserved until the present day. With this high number, however, Roskilde occupies the leading place north of the Alps for towns with a multitude of springs. In addition to the eight named springs, there are springs by the Fjord and in various private gardens.

The water in Roskilde has always been considered to be something special. The large number of springs had different effects: Some springs were thought to be healing for the sick, others were used for drinking water and laundering and some for motive power or they served as water supply for man and animals. Book a guide to hear about Roskilde's unique history of springs.
